Anasacia - Edema or Dropsy

Apoplexia - A stroke

Catarrh - Nasal or throat membrane inflammation with fever

Consumption - Tuberculosis

Debilitas - Generalized weakness

Diphtheria - Contageous throat disease

Dropsy - Congestive heart failure

Dysentery - Intestinal membrane infalmmation

Enteritis - Inflammation of the bowels

Erysipelas - Infectious, streptococcus-based skin deisease with fever

Febris - Fever

Gangrene - Death od soft tissue on the body

Incipit Hydrothorax - Abnormal amounts of fluids in the pleural cavity

Meningitis - Inflammation of the brain

Nephritis - Inflammation of the kidneys

Peritonitis - Inflammation of the peritoneum

Pyemia - Pyrogenic bacteria in the blood causing abcesses

Rubeola - Measles

Typhoid fever - Highly infectious disease marked by intestinal ulcers and inflammation with fever

Typhus - Infectious disease affecting the skin and nerves spread by lice and fleas

Variola - smallpox

Vulnus - Pertaining to a wound

Vulnus Incisum - Wound caused by cut

Vulnus Punctum - Wound caused by cut

Vulnus Sclopeticum - Gunshot wound
